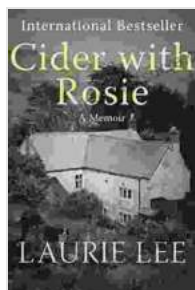

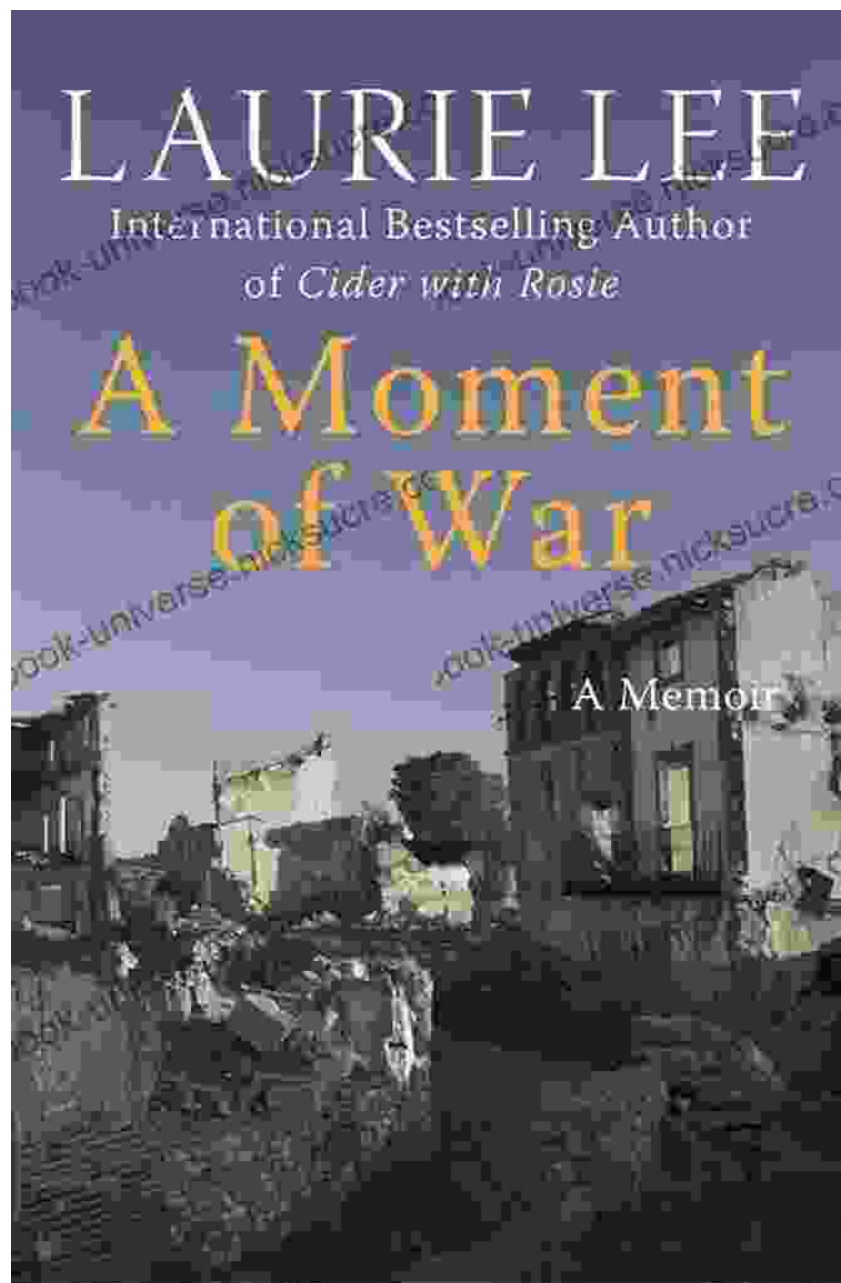


Cover of 'As I Walked Out One Midsummer Morning' by Laurie Lee

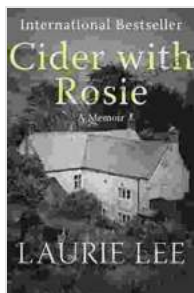

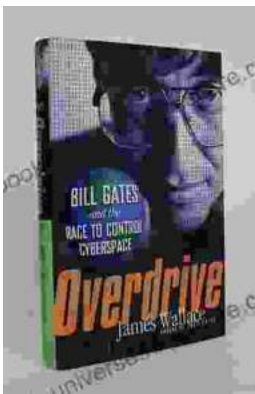

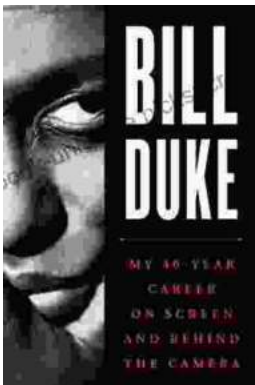
