I know that my thoughts are not always popular. But I don't care. I'm not trying to please everyone. I'm just trying to be true to myself.

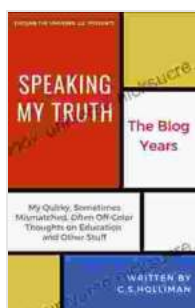

- I believe that everyone should be required to take a nap every day.

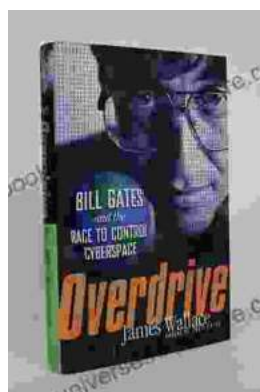
