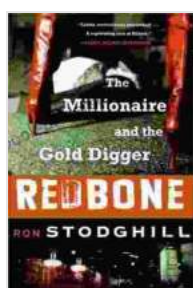


Redbone Malice And Murder Inside Atlanta Black

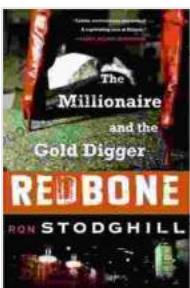

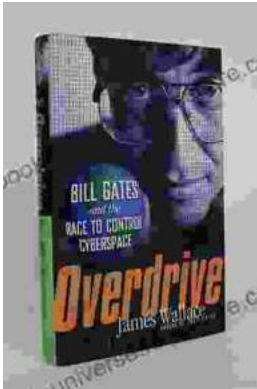

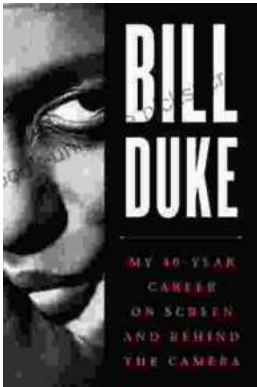
