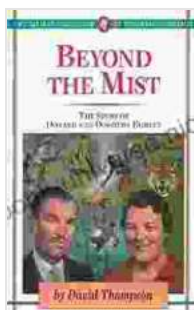


# The Story of Donald and Dorothy Fairley: The Jaffray Collection of Missionary Papers and Photographs

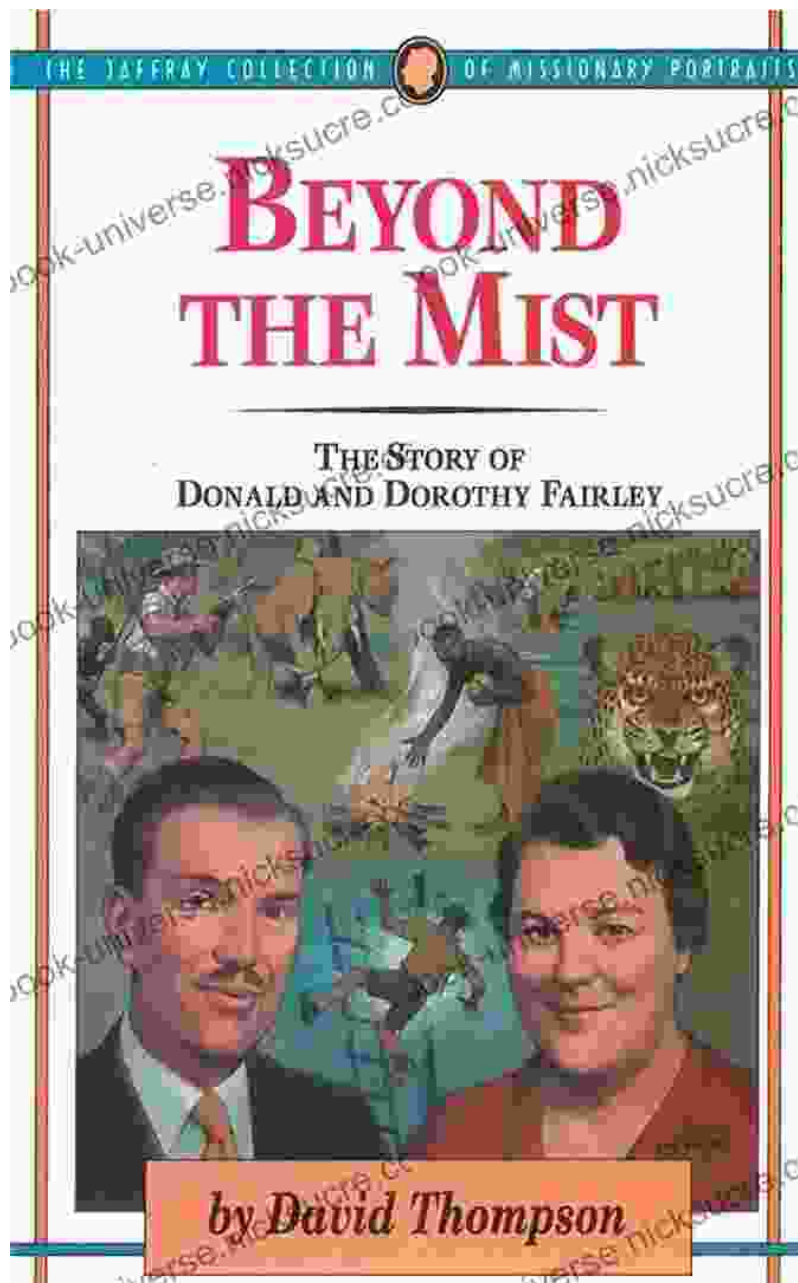

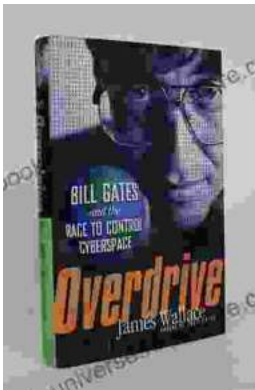

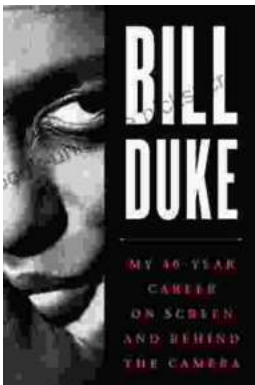
